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2-SUITER BIDS

The play in 6D (hand 4) is very exciting.

Must make use of info given in bidding.

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Look at the following 2 bidding auctions -

A		B	
N	S	N	S
1NT	2D*	1C	1H
2H	4H	4H	?

In auction A, the 4♥ bid is a shutbid. Partner may NOT go on.

In auction B, North must have at least 19 points (revalued) since South can have 6 points. The 4♥ bid actually welcomes a slam try if South has the goods.

2-suiter bids - revision.

(1D) - 2D as an overcall will show both majors minimum 5-5. Strength - 4-11 points at white and 9-13 points at red.

Now look at the hands on the left.

1. Ghestem then a free bid at 5-level?
2. N/S received 75%. Easy game, eh?
3. -1 gave them 33% (1C was 16+)
4. Optimum 6D reached, but should make! -1 also was 33%.

Go through the play in 6D. When ♣Q was played at trick 7 and covered, ruff it with the last trump! Now ♠K - ♠A then exit a spade and East is endplayed = he has to return a heart into the A-J!
